WORLDWIDE DAY OF ATONEMENT CELEBRATION PRAYER SERVICE – SAT, OCT 4, 2014 IN-CHURCH VIEWING

This document covers everything you need to know to have a successful connection to view the Worldwide Day of Atonement Celebration Prayer Service in your church.

Document Updates

LIVE STREAMING

The LIVE Streaming of the Day of Atonement 2014 service is dependent on your viewing location's Internet connection, the viewing computer's specs, and the visual equipment used to transmit the computer's display to your audience.

Minimum System Requirements

CPU: Intel Core 2 Duo or AMD Third Generation Opteron processor

RAM: 2 GB of RAM

Operating System: Windows XP SP 3 or Mac OS X Leopard (10.5) (or better)

<u>Internet Connection</u>: *Business-Class BROADBAND Internet Connection with a minimum of 5 mbps (mega-bits per second) downstream (Business-Class Cable, DSL, etc.)

(NOT Supported: Dial-Up, Satellite, Wireless, or Cellular connections, or connections under 5 mbps downstream)

Connectivity to Computer: CAT 5 Ethernet hard-wired to BROADBAND Modem

Internet Browser: Google Chrome 30.0+, Mozilla Firefox 25.0+, or Internet Explorer 8.0+

Adobe Flash: Adobe Flash version 10

* - Shared BROADBAND Connections are the most common connection from Cable and DSL providers. Because the bandwidth on the connection is shared, and not dedicated or guaranteed, network slow-downs, especially during "Peak" Internet usage times, should be expected. Peak Internet usage times are known to be between 7pm and 1am, local time, globally, depending on your area and proximity to the Internet backbone your ISP uses to provide your service. Because this increased demand on Internet bandwidth which will be hitting *during* the service streaming opportunity may influence the streaming quality on shared connections, we recommend the system requirements, and a guaranteed-bandwidth, dedicated Internet connection detailed in the section below.

RAM: 4 GB of RAM (or better)

Operating System: Windows 7 SP 1 or OS X Mountain Lion (10.8.2)

<u>Internet Connection</u>: Guaranteed-Bandwidth BROADBAND Internet Connection with a minimum of 20 mbps (mega-bits per second) downstream, or Guaranteed-Bandwidth Dedicated Corporate Class connection (T1, Fiber Optics)

Connectivity to Computer: CAT 5e Ethernet hard-wired Internet Connection

Internet Browser: Google Chrome 33.0+, Mozilla Firefox 27.0+, or Internet Explorer 9.0+

Adobe Flash: Adobe Flash version 11

Test Sessions

One (1) private and one (1) shared test session will be held by the web and I.T departments of World Harvest Church to help prepare you for the Day of Atonement streaming service.

The test sessions are designed to test your Internet connection availability during peak Internet hours, as close as possible to the time that the actual stream will be provided. The READY Session is designed to set up your Internet connection and video hardware, and provide a working proof, before the LIVE stream begins.

Because the test sessions are designed to test different aspects of the stream, please do your utmost to participate in all sessions provided. The dates and times of those sessions are as follows:

We recommend using Google Chrome for its Adobe Flash sandboxing feature. You can download Google Chrome from <u>google.com/chrome</u>. You can download Adobe's Flash player at http://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/.
- 2. Click on the image/button/link on that page to launch the LIVE Streaming player in a new tab or window.
- 3. The live stream should begin automatically. If it does not, hit the "play" button in the lower left-hand corner.
- 4. Hit the "full-screen" button on the lower right-hand corner to launch the player in its full-screen format.

The stream will begin broadcast for connection purposes at 6:45pm ET. The Day of Atonement service will not be re-broadcast, however the service archive will be made available for you to play in your church as soon as possible after the service has concluded. We expect the archive will be available by 8:45pm ET.
